

# GOOD STANDING FRAMEWORK

## What is Good Standing?

Good Standing provides a system that assists in ensuring that our students maintain a satisfactory level of attendance, academic participation and behaviour. Good Standing procedures are a mandatory requirement for all public schools.

Good Standing compliments the Marangaroo Primary School student services processes and works in conjunction with our school's positive behaviour expectation plan. It reinforces the standard of behaviour and engagement expected by our school community.

Good Standing is a status that all students at Marangaroo automatically achieve. Maintaining Good Standing is an incentive for students as it enables them to participate in classroom, school and interschool privileges, responsibilities and activities that are in addition to the regular learning program. Loss of Good Standing occurs as a result of high level behaviour incidences that result in suspension or withdrawal from class and/or ongoing low level misbehaviour in class and in the playground.

### Good Standing

Students are able to participate in classroom, school and interschool privileges, responsibilities and activities that are in addition to the regular learning program

- Adhere to the school classroom and playground expectations
- Complete class work, homework and assessments
- Behave in a way that is appropriate and inclusive of staff and student rights
- Maintain satisfactory attendance (above 90%) and punctuality (including after break periods)



### Caution Zone

Students will be able to participate in additional classroom and school activities but not interschool activities. Classroom and school privileges will also be restricted- Use of Behaviour Monitoring Card

- Repeat of Level 1 behaviours in class or playground
- Late to class after a break more than 3 times in one week
- Refusing to complete set tasks or leaving the classroom without permission
- Unauthorised absence is starting to be of concern



### Loss of Good Standing

Students will not be permitted to participate in classroom, school and interschool privileges, and activities that are in addition to the regular learning program- Use of Behaviour Monitoring Card

- Repeat of undesired behaviours. At least 3 x Level 2 incidents in one week. Refer to our Positive Behaviour Expectations Plan
- Any Level 3 incident including- physical harm to others, abuse of staff, leaving school grounds without permission
- Attendance is below 90% (not including authorised absence)



## What is the process moving in and out of Good Standing?

Students who move out of Good Standing into the Caution Zone or Lost Good Standing will have their behaviour monitored through a 'Behaviour Monitoring Card' for a period of one week. Students will be supported to understand how to achieve good standing back again. At the end of monitoring week, the school leadership team in conjunction with the class teacher, will decide whether the student has earned the right to hold Good Standing again.

All staff are responsible for monitoring Good Standing status and working with the leadership team where students do not regain their Good Standing.
